To ensure that Ecological Organic Agriculture is integrated into the various countries' agricultural systems.

Overview

The overall objective of the KCOA project is to introduce knowledge hubs successfully as an innovative strategy for promoting organic agriculture with actors in the regions of Eastern, Western, Northern, Central and Southern Africa.

The KCOA project is being implemented by GIZ with funding from BMZ and the Eastern Africa hub is being hosted and coordinated by Biovision Africa Trust and cohosted by PELUM Uganda. The Continental Digital Knowledge Platform is part of the KCOA project coordinated by GIZ.

The KHEA Project is expected to be aligned to the Ecological Organic Agriculture Initiative (EOA-I), an African Union-led continental undertaking with the oversight of African Union Commission (AUC) Department of Rural Economy and Agriculture.

The Commission provides oversight through the Continental Steering Committee of the EOA-I that it chairs.

The KHEA Project in Eastern Africa is being implemented in 4 countries of Kenya, Uganda, Rwanda and Tanzania. It is expected later to bring on board Madagascar.

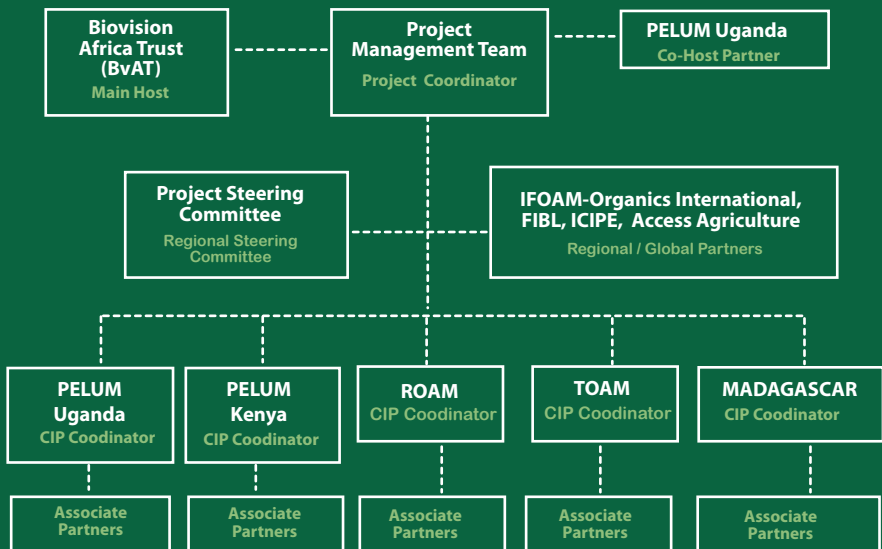
2 Capacity Building and Dissemination of Organic Agriculture Knowledge

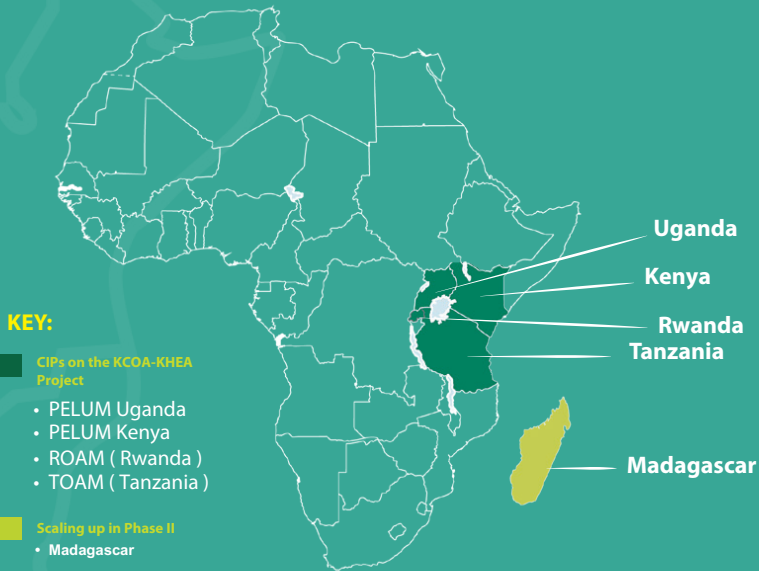
3 Networking within the Organic Agriculture Value Chains
